Subject: Section 18 Exemption for Halosulfuron-methyl to Control Yellow Nutsedge on Asparagus

Information courtesy of Thomas Kaczoroski, Emergency Exemption Coordinator for the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection Pesticide Control Program (NJDEP PCP):

Action: EPA has granted a specific exemption under Section 18 of FIFRA to the NJDEP for the use of **halosulfuron-methyl to control yellow nutsedge on asparagus**. This specific exemption expires December 1, 2002. A time-limited tolerance has been established and will expire on December 31, 2003.

Product: The product Sandea Herbicide containing 75% halosulfuron-methyl, (EPA registration number 10163-254) manufactured by Gowan Company is to be used in accord with its product label. The exemption is subject to the conditions of NJDEP's request for exemption, as well as conditions and exemptions specifically listed in the exemption letter from EPA.
