Subject: Section 18 Exemption for the Use of Pronamide to Control Dodder on Cranberry

Information courtesy of Thomas Kaczoroski, Emergency Exemption Coordinator for the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection Pesticide Control Program (NJDEP PCP):

Action: EPA has granted a specific exemption under Section 18 of FIFRA to the NJDEP for the use of **pronamide to**

control dodder on cranberries. This specific exemption follows a crisis exemption issued in June 2002 by the NJDEP PCP for the use of pronamide to control weeds (dodder) on cranberries. This crisis exemption covered the time period June 3, 2002 to December 15, 2002. This specific exemption under Section 18 also expires December 15, 2002.

Product: The product Kerb 50-W, (EPA registration number 707-159) manufactured by Rohm and Haas may be used in accord with its product label. The exemption is subject to the conditions of NJDEP's request for exemption, as well as conditions and exemptions specifically listed in the exemption letter from EPA.
