## **Open Comment Periods**

- 1. REDs:
  - Amendment to the Rodenticide Cluster and Zinc Phosphide Reregistration Eligibility Decision (RED).

- 2. IREDs: The release of individual Interim Registration Eligibility Decisions (IRED) for the following 3 organophosphates is the latest in a series of actions EPA has taken to ensure that pesticides meet the safety standard established under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) as amended by the Food Quality Protection Act (FQPA). The interim risk management decision document on these pesticides cannot be considered final until consideration of organophosphorus cumulative risks is complete (see below). EPA will then issue its final tolerance reassessment decision for each of these pesticides; which would reflect any further risk mitigation needed.

Its purpose is to consider the <u>cumulative</u> risks of the organo-phosphorus pesticides, which share a common mechanism of toxicity. The preliminary <u>cumulative</u> risk assessment considers potential exposures to 31 organophosphates through food, drinking water, and residential uses.
