Date Effective: July 2, 2002. EPA has granted a specific exemption under Section 18 of FIFRA to the NJDEP for the use of fludioxonil, formulated as *Scholar 50 WP* to control brown rot, gray mold, and Rhixopus rot on peaches and nectarines. This product is applied postharvest. The unregistered product *Scholar 50 WP*, manufactured by Novartis, may be used under this exemption. The expiration date of this specific exemption is September 30, 2002.

The exemption is subject to the conditions of NJDEP's request for exemption, as well as the product label, and conditions and exemptions specifically listed in the exemption letter from EPA. Please email or call with your fax number if you wish a copy of the exemption letter to be faxed to you.
