 > >
 > > EPA has published a cancellation order for registrations of all
 > > ethion pesticide products by three registrants. This cancellation
 > > order follows a notice in the September 26, 2001, Federal
 > > Register announcing receipt of requests for cancellation of
 > > these products and a public comment period. EPA has received
 > > no comments, and is therefore granting the requested cancellation
 > > orders. Any distribution, sale, or use of the products subject to
 > > this cancellation order is only permitted in accordance with the
 > > terms of the existing stocks provisions of this cancellation order.
 > > Cancellation of manufacturing-use products will be effective on
 > > October 1, 2003, and cancellation of end-use products will be
 > > effective on December 31, 2003. Sale of existing stocks is
 > > prohibited as of October 1, 2004, and use of these products
 > > will be prohibited as of December 31, 2004.
